The Highway Department reported they had finished Baker Hill Road, 239 loads of gravel, 242 labor hours combined, 6,750 feet ready for profiling, preparing Coykendall Road for profiling, 3,800 feet of gravel to be used, replaced 3 culvert driveway pipes and ditched Coykendall Road, replaced radiator on #6 Volvo (green), preparing all roads with cold patch that will be getting chip seal, gathered old recycle tanks from 15 years ago that have been laying around shop and scrapped tanks for \$1,422.44, graded and raked all dirt roads, attended PERMA training at Community Center 9 4 Hours) and ordered all sign material that was needed for Town.

Code Officer Husted reported that he had issued 9 Building Permits, 3 Notices of Violation were issued, 23 Construction inspections completed, 1 Operating Permits issued, 0 Demolition permits issued, 0 Stop Work Order issued, 0 Fire Prevention & Property maintenance inspections completed, 1 Violations corrected, 0 Court appearance tickets issued, 11 Projects completed and permits issued, 0 Certificates of Occupancy issued, 0 Certificate of Compliance issued, and 0 violation complaints are still not corrected, and 0 Building permits remain uncompleted, 0 tent installation inspections were completed, 0 cases are pending in Court, 0 Building permit for new manufactured home, 0 annual mobile home park operating permits issued, and 0 Water & Sewer connection completed.

RESOLVED, that the Dix Town Board accepts the following:

**STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW
ACT
TYPE II RESOLUTION REGARDING
TOWN OF DIX WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, the Town of Dix is seeking to undertake a water system improvement project aimed at removing contaminants, trihalomethanes, from the water distribution system; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance the State Environmental Quality Review Act (“SEQRA”), the Town of Dix is required to assess impacts to the environment in compliance with SEQRA regulations included in 6 NYCRR Part 617; and

WHEREAS, Section 617.5 of the SEQRA regulations provides that certain activities are Type II actions which are not subject to review under SEQRA and that such activities include “maintenance or repair involving no substantial changes in an existing structure or facility” (§ 617.5(c)(1)), “replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site” (§ 617.5(c)(2)),

"construction or expansion of a primary or accessory appurtenant non- residential structure or facility involving less than 4,000 square feet of gross floor area" (§ 617.5(c)(7)); and,

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements consist solely of adding a treatment device within an existing water storage tank, replacing existing pumps and replacing existing controls within existing water system facilities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BASED ON SUCH REVIEW AND CONSIDERATION, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town of Dix Town Board that:

1. The Town of Dix Town Board is the lead agency for the SEQRA review of the proposed project.
2. The proposed water system improvement project is a Type II action which is not subject to review under SEQRA, and it will not result in a significant adverse impact on the environment.
3. The Supervisor is hereby authorized to sign and file or have filed on behalf of the Town all documents necessary to comply with SEQRA.
4. This resolution is effective immediately.

WHEREAS, the Town Board engaged Fagan Engineers & Land Surveyors, PC, to review odor issues associated with the Wedgewood Road and County Road 17 sanitary sewer located between Meads Hill Road and the Village of Watkins Glen; and

WHEREAS, Fagan Engineers & Land Surveyors, PC, prepared an engineering report dated December 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board proposes repairs to a section of the sanitary sewer as indicated in the report; and

WHEREAS, 6 NYCRR Section 617.5 (Title 6 of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations) under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQR) provides that certain actions identified in subdivision (c) of that section are not subject to environmental review under the Environmental Conservation Law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Dix hereby determines that the proposed “Repairs and Upgrades to the Wedgewood Rd. & County Rd. 17 Sanitary Sewer” project is a Type II action in accordance with 6 NYCRR Section 17.5(c)(1) which constitutes maintenance or repair involving no substantial changes in an existing structure or facility, and is therefore not subject to review under 6 NYCRR Part 617.
